Purpose of this Scholarship

The primary purpose of this Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to young people at Saint Patrick's Church who are planning to enroll in a university or college diploma or degree program and who, as members of Saint Patrick's Church, have demonstrated an exemplary commitment to the service of others in their high school years.

The secondary purpose of this Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to young people within the geographical area of Saint Patrick's Church who are graduating from Junior High entering a High School program.

Value of this Scholarship

Each year, a Scholarship Committee appointed by Saint Patrick's Site Coordinating Committee will award one university or college entrance scholarship –valued at \$1000. Canadian to a young parishioner who, in the opinion of the Scholarship Committee, best meets the eligibility criteria.

In the event that no applications have been received from your parishioners by the deadline in any given year, the Scholarship Committee shall immediately conduct a search for other possible applicants within the geographical area of Saint Patrick's Church.

The committee will also donate \$500. Annually to a local Junior High school in our area for the purpose of providing five students there with high school entrance bursaries valued at \$100 each. These bursaries are to be disbursed at the discretion of officials at the Junior High.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants shall be high school students who have lived in Nova Scotia for the past year, and who have demonstrated an exemplary commitment to the service of others in their High School years.

Junior high applicants shall be individuals who have lived in Nova Scotia for the past year and who are in the opinion of officials of said Junior High, particularly deserving of aid.

All scholarships are tenable in Canada, or elsewhere, at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee.

Applications

The application deadline for the George P. Leach, S.J. Scholarship is Wednesday, June 8, 2022.

In the event that no applications have been received from young parishioners by June 8, 2022 in any given year, the Scholarship Committee shall immediately conduct a search for other possible applicants within the geographical area of Saint Patrick's Church. The deadline for these applicants will be August 16, 2022.

Selection

Selection of scholarship recipients will be made each year once all applications have been reviewed. The Committee reserves the right to award a scholarship to any person they deem qualified, or not to award in any given year.
